ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

Lions Club of Springfield, Oregon

We, Bryce Thalman, William Boyd, W. O. Dahl, Tom Fendren and Donald

Dericksen, of Leers of the Lions Club of Springfield, Oregon, an existing voluntary association, whose names are hereunto subscribed, desiring to form a corporation under and by virtue of Chapter 462, Oregon Laws, 1941, providing for the creation of nonprofit corporations, do hereby associate ourselves together and make and execute in triplicate the following articles of incorporation,

I.

The name assumed by this corporation and by which it shall be known is the Lions Club of Springfield, Oregon and its duration shall be perpetual unless terminated by the members thereof.

II.

This corporation shall not engage in any form of trade or commerce, or carry on any activity which will result in a remunerative profit to the corporation or to its members. Subject to the foregoing limitations, the object, business, or pursuit of this corporation shall be as follows:

To create and foster a spirit of generous consideration among the peoples of the world through a study of the problems of international relationships from the standpoint of business and professional ethics.

To promote the theory and practice of good government and good citizenship.

To take an active interest in the civic, commercial, social and moral welfare of the community; and to this end, to sponsor such community welfare, charitable and educational projects as may be such group seem proper.

To unite the members in the bonds of friendship, good fellowship and mutual understanding.

To provide a forum for the full and free discussion of all matters of public interest, partisan politics and sectarian religion along excepted.

To encourage efficiency and promote high ethical standards in business and professions; provided that no one shall hold out as one of the corporation's objects, financial benefits to any of its members.

The estimated value of the property and money possessed by this corporation at the time of executing these articles of incorporation is ONE THOUSAND (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS and its revenue shall be derived from dues, gifts, donations, bequests and the proceeds of benefit projects and ventures.
