A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

of the state of, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:
ONE: The name of this corporation shall be:

THREE: This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as

purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt

The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are:
A. The purposes for which the is organized are exclusively
charitable and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal
Revenue Code of 1986 the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue
law.
B. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry
on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal
income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the
corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
C. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more
exempt purposes with the meaning of section (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or
corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal
government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not
so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in
which the principle office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such
purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and
operated exclusively for such purposes.

D. To solicit, collect and otherwise raise money to fund those aims and goals of the which are exclusively charitable and within the
meaning of section (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
E. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
F. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
FOUR: The manner in which the Directors are elected are as follows:
